PRESS RELEASE

The General Manager of the Cameroon National Shippers' Council (CNSC) hereby informs shippers, especially importers, ship-owners, carriers, ships' agents, freight forwarders and other maritime sector actors that the import Electronic Cargo Tracking Note (ECTN) is issued upon presentation of the following documents:

- A copy of the original Bill of Lading;
- A copy of the original detailed Commercial Invoice (s) duly signed by the supplier or the seller;
- A copy of the original freight invoice.

As a reminder, in keeping with the provisions of **Article 10 (new) of Order No. 000289/MINT of 5 March 2007** to institute the Electronic Cargo Tracking Note, all business persons should contact CNSC's representatives in the geographical areas of the Port / country of loading for the establishment of ECTN for import no later than 2 (two) days prior to the arrival of the ship carrying their cargo.

Shippers who fail to comply with this measure shall have their applications files for the issuance of ECTN rejected.
